

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. APPLICATION FOR SPACE

All applications for trade stand sites must be made by completing the application form which must be signed by the Exhibitor; such a signature being an acceptance of these Terms. Such application and these Terms constitute the entire contract between Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic and the Exhibitor and may only be varied in writing being signed by the Exhibitor and an authorized representative of Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic.

Application forms must be completed and returned no later than the 7th of May 2010 together with fees in full. A separate application form is required for each stand should an Exhibitor require more than one.

Prior to the 7th of May 2010 £25.00 deposit will be accepted, to retain your stand. All balances must be fully paid by the 7th of May 2010.

No site will be reserved until the completed application form and full deposit/payment has been received. Applications received after the 7th of May 2010 may be subject to a 20% surcharge.

Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic reserves the right to refuse any application, whether received prior to the closing date for applications or not, and is not obliged to give any reason for such refusal. Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic also reserves the right to cancel any application which may have been previously accepted without any reason being given for such cancellation, in which case any fees paid will be refunded to the Exhibitor, but no other compensation damages or penalty will be payable to the Exhibitor.

In the event of cancellation of the event, any fees paid will be refunded to the Exhibitor, but no other compensation, damages or penalty will be payable to the Exhibitor.

2. FACILITIES AVAILABLE

Open ground space only is let - exhibitors make their own arrangements for any structures and equipment required i.e. marquees, shell systems, tables, chairs etc.

The allocation of sites and the positioning of trade stands will be entirely at the discretion of Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic, although every endeavor will be made to meet any request by an Exhibitor regarding the position of his stand.

3. ALLOCATION OF SPACE

The area applied for must include all ground necessary for the erection of guy ropes and stays which under no circumstances will be allowed to project beyond the Exhibitor's allocated area. To **guarantee** parking space for support vehicles adjacent to the stand this space must be included in the area applied for. Where a marquee is to be sited a space of at least 1m between the marquee sides and the boundary of the stand must be allowed on all sides to comply with safety regulations. Permission must be obtained at the time of application for stands over 5.4m (18') high

Allocation of space is personal to the Exhibitor who shall not assign or transfer his rights, nor shall he sub-let any of the space allotted to him. Any Exhibitor found to have moved his stand without permission from Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic, shall be removed from the venue.

4. EXHIBITOR'S WITHDRAWAL OR CANCELLATION OF SPACE RESERVED

If for any reason whatsoever a trade stand is cancelled by the Exhibitor, 50% of the total fees shall be refunded provided Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic is notified in writing not less than four weeks prior to the commencement of the event. Any later cancellation will result in the forfeit of the total amount of fees paid. Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic reserves the right in all such instances to re-let the space without accounting to the Exhibitor.

5. RESTRICTED GOODS

The sale of jokes and tricks including any article containing or capable of discharging any noxious smell, noise, colored spray, foam or other product that could be a nuisance or annoyance to any other person within the venue is not permitted. The sale of knives & catapults is restricted to persons over the age of 18 years.

Exhibitors may NOT sell or donate either inflated or deflated balloons on the venue for reasons of animal safety.

6. FIRE & SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Trade stands will be inspected by the Fire Officer to ensure compliance with fire regulations

7. CATERING

Exhibitors may supply refreshments free of charge to their customers. However, under no circumstances will they or anyone else on their stand be permitted to sell or receive money for refreshments without the written permission of Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic. Exhibitors catering on their own stands are reminded that they must conform to the requirements of the Food Hygiene Regulations.

8. NOISE

Exhibitors must not use any public address equipment. Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic shall have power to stop any activity which by reason of smoke, noise, smell or other nuisance is offensive to neighboring exhibitors or the public.

9. COLLECTIONS & APPEALS

Charitable or other institutions wishing to make appeals for contributions to their funds must first obtain permission from Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic.

10. GENERATORS AND ELECTRICITY

Generators are permitted providing they are moderately sized and do not reach a noise or emission level whereby they become a nuisance to others. Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic is empowered to stop the use of any such equipment if, in their opinion, it is causing a nuisance to others or is in a dangerous condition. The equipment must comply with Health & Safety regulations.

11. PHONE LINES

Are not available.

12. WATER

Water is available via taps at a number of points around the venue.

13. MARQUEE AND FURNITURE HIRE

These facilities are available by prior arrangement. Please contact Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic office for contact details.

14. STAND PREPARATION & REMOVAL

Exhibitors may commence work on their stands on or after Wednesday the 14th of July 2010. All stands must be in position and fully operational not later than 9.00 am on Thursday the 15th of July 2010. Exhibitors who wish to commence work on their stand prior to the 14th of July 2010 should apply to Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic for permission.

During the build-up period the venue is open between the hours of 9.00 am - 6.30 pm.

Exhibitors wishing to enter the venue outside these times should apply to Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic for permission.

The dismantling of stands may not commence before the completion of the final competitions. All stands must be removed not later than 4.00 pm on Monday 19th of July 2010.

15. TIMES OF OPENING (Subject to Alteration)

10.00 am - end of competitions in the outside arenas (approximately 7.00 pm). Stands should be open during this period.

16. SECURITY

Property of an Exhibitor remains on the venue at the sole risk of the Exhibitor; Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic will not be responsible for any loss or damage to Exhibitor's property. Exhibitors are advised to make their own arrangements for the security of their stands and to take out appropriate insurance. Exhibitors are advised to insure against fire and public liability, not only as regards their own property but also against third party claims.

17. TICKETS & CAR PARKING

Each stand will be allocated one vehicle pass. Tickets will be posted to exhibitors approximately two weeks prior to the show.

18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic, its officers, representatives and employees will not be responsible to any person whatsoever whilst upon, entering on, or leaving the venue for any damage, death injury or accident to persons or property or for lost or stolen items.

19. INDEMNITY

The Exhibitor must keep Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic, its officers employees and representatives fully indemnified against all losses actions, costs, claims, demands and expenses arising directly or indirectly out of any act, omission or negligence of the Exhibitor or any persons attending the event expressly or impliedly with the Exhibitor's authority and in respect of any breach or non-observance by the Exhibitor of these Terms.

20. COMPLIANCE WITH DIRECTIONS

Exhibitors must comply with any directions, verbal or in writing made by an authorized representative of Bolesworth Castle Show Jumping Classic and whether relating to safety, security or for any other reason relating to the management and organization of the event.

21. STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS

Exhibitors must comply with the requirements of any Act of Parliament, by-law or the requirements of any public local or other authority in relation to the Exhibitor's stand, its use or equipment used in connection with it.

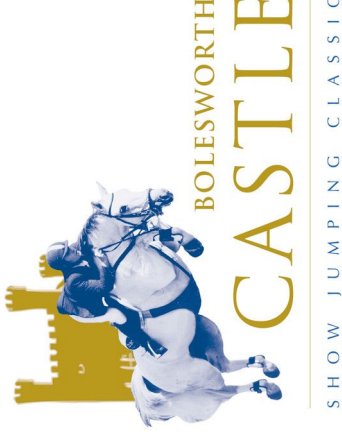
22. NOTICES AND COMMUNICATIONS
